Project Area Receipt and Delivery Capacity - Update

Non-Critical Notice

NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) continues to review mainline receipt capacity on the NGTL System. Based on existing and future Firm Transportation - Receipt (FT-R) and Firm Transportation – Delivery (FT-R) commitments by Customers NGTL advises that effective January 1, 2016, the following areas are now fully contracted:

FT-R in the Peace River/Mainline Project Area

The Groundbirch Mainline and Gordondale Lateral are now fully contracted. FT-R transfer requests from off the Groundbirch Mainline or Gordondale Lateral into stations on the Groundbirch Mainline or Gordondale Lateral cannot be accommodated at this time.

FT-D in the Mainline Project Area

The Banff Transmission Line is now fully contracted. FT-D transfer requests from off the Banff Transmission Line into stations on the Banff Transmission Line cannot be accommodated at this time.

Areas that are fully contracted or are approaching contract capacity are identified on the NGTL System Availability Maps posted on the TransCanada Customer Express website at the following link:

Capacity within any portion of the NGTL System can become fully contracted at any time and without prior notice. NGTL encourages customers to review their existing and future firm contract requirements to ensure their firm contract levels align with expected flow requirements.

FT-R/FT-D New Service

Customers interested in new firm service at locations within fully contracted areas should submit their requests to their Customer Account Manager. New requests for FT-R or FT-D service in these areas will be included in future mainline facility expansion plans. NGTL does not include Interruptible Transportation - Receipt (IT-R) or Interruptible Transportation – Delivery (IT-D) volumes in the design for additional facilities.

FT-R/FT-D Transfers

All transfer requests within the fully contracted areas are reviewed by NGTL to determine hydraulic impact to the system and are subject to the NGTL Tariff regarding service transfers. Previously approved transfers are not indicative of future approvals.
