Project Area Receipt and Delivery Capacity - Update Non-Critical Notice

NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) continues to review mainline and lateral capacity on the integrated NGTL System. Based on existing and future Firm Transportation – Delivery (FT-D) and Firm Transportation – Receipt (FT-R) commitments, NGTL advises that the following updates are in effect immediately:

FT-D in the Mainline Project Area

The following laterals are now fully contracted:

Gleichen-Cluny - Standard Lateral

Glenwood-Brocket Lateral

FT-R in the Peace River Project Area

The following laterals are now approaching contract capacity:

Cutbank Lateral (previously fully contracted)

The following laterals are no longer fully contracted:

Bear River Lateral

Ferrier North Lateral

Kaybob Lateral

Robb Lateral

FT-R in the Mainline Project Area

The following laterals are no longer fully contracted:

Bowmanton West Lateral

Wayne-Dalum Lateral

Capacity within any portion of the NGTL System can become fully contracted at any time and without prior notice. NGTL encourages customers to review their existing and future firm contract requirements to ensure their firm contract levels align with expected flow requirements.

FT-D/FT-R New Service

Customers interested in new firm service at locations within fully contracted areas should submit their requests to their Customer Account Manager. New requests for firm service in these areas will be included in future mainline facility expansion plans. NGTL does not include Interruptible Transportation – Delivery (IT-D) or Interruptible Transportation – Receipt (IT-R) volumes in the design for additional facilities.

FT-D/FT-R Transfers

Requests for transfers within fully contracted areas will be reviewed by NGTL to determine hydraulic impact to the system and are subject to the NGTL Tariff regarding service transfers. Previously approved transfers are not indicative of future approvals.
