Delivery Capacity Update Non-Critical Notice

NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) continues to review mainline and lateral capacity on the integrated NGTL System. Based on Customers' existing and future Firm Transportation – Delivery (FT-D) commitments, NGTL advises that the Turin Lateral is now fully contracted. Expansion of mainline and lateral facilities may be required in order to provide incremental delivery capacity. If NGTL determines that expansion facility additions are required, information regarding such expansions will be provided to the Tolls, Tariff, Facilities & Procedures (TTFP) committee. NGTL does not include Interruptible Transportation – Delivery (IT-D) volumes when planning facilities expansions.

Capacity within any portion of the NGTL System can become fully contracted at any time and without prior notice. NGTL encourages customers to review their existing and future firm contract requirements to ensure their firm contract levels align with expected flow requirements.

Requests for transfers within constrained area(s) will be reviewed by NGTL and allowed if the effect to the area is hydraulically neutral or beneficial. FT-D transfers are requested and assessed through NGTL's FT-D: Transfers Open Season found at the following link:
